Breeding Contract

Stallion: *Noble Prize*⁺⁺ AHR# 0572783 Mare _____ Reg. # _____

This contract is between Heaven Sent Farm (HSF) of Mechanicsville, Virginia, the owner of the above mentioned stallion, and hereafter described as HSF, and _____, owner of the above mentioned mare hereafter described as owner.

It is hereby understood and agreed that the owner wishes this mare to be bred to this stallion. To bring this about the owner and HSF agree to the following:

1. Owner agrees to pay a breeding of \$1,500.00 consisting of a booking fee of \$500.00 paid at the time of execution of this agreement and the balance paid prior to initial semen shipment or insemination. In addition to this breeding fee, if the owner requests transported semen, a collection fee of \$250.00 per shipment will be charged plus Federal Express freight costs of \$75.00 for shipments made Monday through Friday. A \$250.00 advanced deposit will be charged for the equitainer, fully refundable upon it's timely and undamaged return. Customer is responsible to arrange and pay freight for the equitainer. (UPS ground or Fedex 2nd day acceptable). All semen shipments will be coordinated through HSF at 434-546-6123, with a minimum of 24-hour notice. Extra charges could apply for shipments not made on Monday through Friday, Same Day airshipments will be charged and additional \$25.00 to cover extra cost of airfreight plus a \$50.00 carrier fee to take shipment to the airport. If owner requests mare to be inseminated at HSF facility, there will be a \$15.00 per day board fee charged for the mare, plus \$50.00 per insemination and or all veterinary expenses incurred.

Owner will be responsible for expenses associated with delivering mare to and pickup from HSF facility in Mechanicsville, VA.

2. HSF discloses that the stallion, *Noble Prize*⁺⁺, is SCID clear.
3. HSF recommends a Vet's culture on this mare showing no infection which, may affect breeding, have a Coggins Test for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) taken within 180 days showing a negative result, have mare current with inoculations against Tetanus, Eastern and Western Encephalitis, Venezuelan Equine Encephalitis (VEE), Strangles and Equine Influenza prior to delivery or before semen shipment. Mare owner should keep said mare in good physical condition throughout pregnancy, including vaccination against Rhinopneumonitis at the 5th, 7th, and 9th months of pregnancy. Mare owner should also provide or perform other routine vaccinations, deworming, hoof trimming, teeth floating, and Caslick's procedures as recommended by the mare owner's local veterinarian.
4. Owner agrees to hold HSF and its agents, servants and employees harmless from any and all liability resulting from the death or injury to the above mentioned mare.
